Scheme of Evaluation

1. Internal Assessment (for 30 marks)

- a. The Internal Assessment (IA) of the student shall be done by the respective subject teachers.
- b. The evaluation of students shall be based on two internal tests carrying 10 marks each for all papers and each test shall be of one hour thirty minutes duration for a maximum of 40 marks reduced to 10 later. The total of two tests shall be taken as final IA marks for the test component.
- c. First test shall be conducted in 8th week and second test in 14th week of the respective semester.
- d. Class participation, Tutorials, Assignments, Project works, Field study etc. carry 5 marks for all papers except Computer Application for which there shall be practical exam for maximum of 50 marks reduce to 10 later and 5 marks for journal records
- e. The IA marks awarded to students shall be displayed on notice board of the college within two weeks from the date of conduct of the tests.

2. Semester Examination (for 70 marks)

- a. At the End of each Semester an examination for 70 marks shall be conducted by the College.
- b. The semester end examination shall be conducted ordinarily during the month of Nov/ Dec for odd semesters and during the April/May for the even semesters or as notified by the college from time to time.



Library:

The College has an excellent library with 52000 plus volumes to its credit. It is kept open from 7:30 A.M. to 2:30 P.M. on all working days. It is kept open for more than these specified hours, during examination season. The students are allowed to entry into library only on submission of identity card at the counter. A maximum of 4 Books is issued to students on Borrowers' ticket and from the book bank facility. Arrangements have been made for the students to identify the books available on the computer terminal and the required book can be demanded on a written slip. The reading room receives English and Kannada dailies. In addition, a good number of national weeklies, fortnightlies, international publications and Educational Software CDs are also available. Hence the students are instructed to make full use of the library and reading room facilities and they are expected to maintain absolute silence inside the library.

Library Rules:

- 1) Admission to the library is only on the production of Identity Card.
- 2) All borrowed books should be surrendered at the end of the academic year
- 3) A student can keep the books for not more than two weeks. However he can return the books earlier
- 4) Students are required to make use of the library facility during their free hours
- 5) The Students have to maintain discipline & strict Silence in the Library
- 6) When you go to library, don't misplace books, news papers, periodicals & magazines keep them in their proper place after use
- 7) Do not take out clippings or pages from books & periodicals.

"Pratibhe" – the college souvenir is intended to nurture & bring –out the hidden creative talents of students & provide sufficient scope to mirror the innate multifaceted qualities of the students. "Pratibhe" is an indigenous product of our students' efforts & creation.

The in-house newsletter of the college published quarterly to highlight the various events, activities and achievements taken place in the college.

Scholarships:

At present the SC/ST Scholarships sanctioned by the GOI and scholarship for the Economically Backward sanctioned by BCM department are available to the said category of students. In addition, National merit scholarship, National Loan Scholarship, Sanchi Honnamma Scholarship, scholarship to the children of primary and high school Teachers, scholarship for the physically handicapped, Defence personnel children scholarship, Language scholarship given by central/state are also available.

- 11) Unauthorised outing / tours, get-together during college hours.

Computer Laboratory Facility

Well equipped computer laboratory with air – condition is located over the area of 1397 sq.ft with broad-band internet facility & LAN. The lab has Smart Board, 54 computers, 3 printers, LCD projector, scanner and other peripherals are connected to the network. Useful educational CD packages have been provided to the students & thus lab serves as a resource- center.

To integrate Information System Technology into the present curriculum, the College has Internet connectivity. The faculty & the students are encouraged & allowed to surf the net free of cost. The internet facility is available for the students during college working hours.

Health Club

The college has a multi gym & fitness center with all modern facilities available for students and faculty.

Sports & Games

Vast play ground with 400 mtrs. Track field, tennis-court, sports & game facilities on campus enable students attain physical growth & sportsman spirit. Intra-College & Inter-College matches & Sports Day give the students ample opportunity to exhibit their talents & skills.



Career Guidance & Placement

The college has a separate cell which offers career guidance & placement facilities to the B.Com students. The cell is dedicated to help the students to assess their career interest & aptitude.

Project genesis programme sponsored by Infosys which imparts training to final year students for placement purpose in their company. It organizes mock interviews, group discussions, & training camps. The cell establishes close contact with companies & business houses by which placement opportunities are created for our students. It also guides the students & gives information for career advancement and higher studies. Infosys, Wipro, IBM, Dell Computers, ICICI Bank, Jeojit Finance etc. are some of the organisations that have recruited our students.

Students' Grievance & Redressal Cell:

It is a student support service intended to help students & make the best of their learning environment it takes keen interest in identifying the students' grievance & the concerned officer is accessible to all students at all times. The cell provides counselling to resolve students' problems relating to academic, administration & personal health etc. The cell motivates and supports the students to attend classes regularly & to prepare for the exams systematically

National Cadet Corps (NCC):

The college offers training in Army Wing for the boys & girls. The College is having a NCC company affiliated 36 KAR.BN. Since 1966. Intake limit is 60 cadets of which 12 are reserved for girls. The parades are held on Sunday morning. The total training periods are 40 of 2 hours duration. Apart from regular training like Trekking, Cycle Expedition, Rock Climbing & Social Plantation, Aids-awareness Campaign etc. There is a provision for certificate B & C Exams.



National Social Services (NSS):

The NSS unit of the college was established in 1973 with the strength of 100 volunteers for both boys & girls. The commitment of social services to the society through Shramadana, the college has dynamic & dedicated NSS unit with the motto of "We for You." It has been actively involved in programmes like tree plantation, constructive work in villages etc. A 10 day camp is the special feature of NSS unit.

Youth Red Cross Unit (YRC)

To train the students to involve in national disastrous events & to help in relief activities to affected people, a special wing called as Youth Red Cross Society is opened in the year 2007-08. Students are encouraged to enroll as volunteers in YRC unit.

Eco-Club :

The Eco-Club of our college regularly functions to bring on awareness of environment among students and create the sense of social responsibility towards the society and environment.

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC):

It is established in 2004 as post –accreditation quality assurance measure & it is continuously monitoring the day to day academic activities of the college. IQAC is a catalytic agent working towards realizing the goals of the quality sustenance & enhancement continuously.

Alumni Association:

Past Students educational Association is a strong & active registered body & functioning since 1970 in order to keep liason–link between the past students & the college. I heartily welcome you to A.S.Patil College of Commerce & now you will be proud of the place where you are.




Highlights of the College

- The College has produced 28 rankers to the Karnatak University, Dharwad and 9 gold medalists since inception.
- The College is accredited at the 'A' Grade by NAAC. The staff is highly qualified and experienced.
- Our college was proposed for "College with Potential for Excellence" by UGC regional office , Bangalore
- The college has got a rare distinction from the UGC as an Autonomous Institution from the academic year 2008-09, the college has the autonomy to frame its syllabus & conduct its own evaluation. The final B.Com degree certificate will be awarded by the Rani Channamma University, Belagavi.
- The College has well equipped and computerised spacious library consisting of more than 52,000 plus volumes and the library is functioning from 7 -30 am to 2-30 p.m.
- State of the art infrastructure comprising of well maintained green-lush garden, a magnificent independent building with spacious class rooms, well-equipped labs, high-tech gym unit separately provided, an independent function hall with audio –video facility etc.

- The College encourages the staff to appear for Orientation and Refresher courses to update their knowledge.
- Modern teaching techniques and methods are used by the staff.
- The college has spacious playground to play football, hockey, cricket etc. It has also got 400 mtrs. track.
- The College conducts athletic meets, tournaments and other matches. The College has Separate hostel for boys and girls.

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Courses Offered

The Courses offered here are the three-year degree course in B.Com. In addition to this course, the college also offers self-financing courses like B.B.A., B.C.A., M.B.A., and M.Com. Thus, this college has the distinction of running both the Under-graduate and Post-graduate courses under the same umbrella.

B.Com Course

This is a three-year integrated degree programme of six semesters. It comprises 21 papers including study of three languages initiates the students into higher accounting principles, management & allied disciplines. Computer Application paper is new addition introduced as mandatory for study in all three years of B.Com Course.


Eligibility: Candidates who have passed two-year pre-university Examination of Karnataka State or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto shall be eligible for admission to the B.Com degree programme.

Medium: The medium of instruction shall be English & Kannada for which separate classes are formed at degree level.

Required certificates:

Applications for admission must be made in the prescribed form available in the college office. The duly filled application form along with the following certificates have to be produced at the time of admission:

- 1) Transfer certificate – Original plus two photocopies
- 2) S.S.L.C /PUC Marks card – original plus two photocopies
- 3) Three photocopies of Income Certificate /SC/ST Certificate from Tahasildar along with original for claiming fee exemption.
- 4) Migration / Eligibility Certificate in case of students from outside the state.

- 1) Certificate course – 1 year
- 2) Diploma course – 2 year
- 3) Advance Diploma course – 3 year.

The boy or girl can offer above courses along with their regular study. The detailed information about these Add-on Courses will be made available through separate prospectus.

General Rules:

- 1) Attendance : Permission for admission to the final examination of each semester will not be granted unless a student has put in at least 75% of attendance in each subject. The students are expected to submit an application for leave if the absence is more than 5 days. The parents will be informed of their wards' long absence if any at the end of each month shortage of attendance up to a maximum of 21 days will be condoned by the principal for such candidates who have represented our college at the university /State/ National level activities or participated in NSS / NCC camps for which recommendation of the concerned head is must.
- 2) Admissions are made on a year – to- year basis.
- 3) Parents or Guardians presence during the admission is mandatory.
- 4) The principal reserves the right of admission.
- 5) Fee once paid will not be refunded
- 6) Any Student found with misbehavior or misconduct will be expelled from the college without any prior intimation.
